The main points of advice :



- the POMOTERRI experience (Pollution, environmental mobilisation and industrialised territories: Fos sur Mer, Gardanne and the southern coast of Marseilles),
- Research-Society Interactions, What and How? (an open text for reflection; Chenorkian R.)

ACTIONS OF DATADRIIHM GROUP - 2021-2023

FACILITATE THE MAINTENANCE OF SHARED TOOLS

At DRIIHM level - Updating and restructuring of the geocatalogues in a GeoDRIIHM portal composed of OHM subportals: will facilitate maintenance

At the INEE level - Reflexion on the restructuring of the geocatalogs of the different

INEE devices hosted at In2P3

ORGANIZE THE DATA POLICY

At the INEE level — Redaction of a common framework text for all INEE researchers or researchers involved in one of the INEE's devices + Addition of specific frameworks by device (OHM, ZA, AnaEE, Ecotron, SEEG...)
